

CDI provides interactive and meaningful training and consultations to organizations, professionals and schools that work with young children throughout Los Angeles County.

CDI's Hospital to Home Program ensures that families receive comprehensive services after leaving the hospital to support optimal developmental outcomes.







Bringing Hope and Magic to Life at the CDI Arts Pavilion


